All Town residents please be aware that your driveway needs to be clear for emergency vehicles, such as EMS and Fire Trucks.

SNOW REMOVAL IN ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY

For public safety concerns **please do not push snow from a private driveway into the roadway or into the road right-a-way ditches.** This violates Wisconsin Statutes 88.01, 86.07, 346.94 or 941.30. A citation will be issued who violates.

****NOTICE TO DOG OWNERS****

According to Wisconsin State Statutes, all dogs **MUST** be licensed and have a rabies shot. Proof of immunization by a veterinarian must be presented to the treasurer at the time of obtaining a license. Dog licenses will not be issued without such proof.

A new license is required for each dog every year and is to be obtained by April 1st.
After April 1st, an additional charge of \$5.00 will be made for each delinquent dog license issued.

License fees **\$10.00** for each male and female dog over the age of five (5) months, **\$5.00** for each spayed or neutered dog, all fees payable at the time of application for license. Kennel licenses are \$35.00.

Anyone having more than 4 dogs on their property needs to apply for a kennel license.

A self-addressed, stamped envelope must be submitted with application made by mail for return of the immunization certificate and license.

Property owners not living on the tax premise should notify renters of dog license requirements.

NOTICE TO BUSINESSES AND RESIDENTS IN THE TOWN OF FARMINGTON

Wisconsin State Law requires that 25% of your solid waste be recycled. If you are not separating your trash for recycling, **START NOW!**

ITEMS TO RECYCLE INCLUDE: Clean glass bottles and jars with rings and caps off; Clean in cans with labels off; Clean #1 - #7 plastic bottles and jars; Newspapers, magazines, catalogs and other materials on similar paper separated, bundled and tied or bagged securely; Corrugated cardboard flattened; Large and small electric tools, appliances, electrical wiring and extension cords; All tin, iron and other bi-metals; Aluminum containers/cans; Lead batteries; Waste oil and used oil filters.

YARD WASTE like grass clippings, brush under 6" in diameter and leaves should be composted at home.

REMEMBER, THESE ITEMS ARE BANNED FROM LANDFILLS

FEES FOR GREEN BOX: \$5.00 – 3 Bags or 1 Barrel
(If you have more you will be charged more by operator)

\$15.00 – couch, oversized chair and ALL major appliances such as, stove/oven, water heater, washer, dryer, dishwasher, water softener, water heater, humidifier, microwave.

\$15.00 – Mattress, bedspring, carpeting (carpet can be donated to Y's Way in Watertown)

\$35.00 – All TV's and Computer monitors

\$25.00 – ALL refrigeration units such as, freezer, refrigerator, air conditioner, dehumidifier

\$8.00 per tire – automobile with rims off

\$3.00 per electronic item such as, Computers (desktop, laptop or tablet), keyboards, scanners, speakers, printers, DVD/VCR players, fax machines or other items that plug into a computer.

Town residents using the Green Box site should have recyclable items clean and separated from trash - **before arrival.**

All containers (glass, plastic, in cans) should be triple rinsed

Town residents with private pick-up service **must** have recyclables separated from trash. Waste haulers that service the Town are: Waste Management, GFL Environmental, Johns Disposal and Badgerland Disposal.

**LANDLORDS IN THE TOWN SHOULD INFORM THEIR TENANTS OF THE
RECYCLING REQUIREMENTS.**
